

This privacy policy notice is for this website; cabar.asia and served by Central Asian Bureau for Analytical Reporting the project of the Institute for War & Peace Reporting and governs the privacy of those who use it. The purpose of this policy is to explain to you how we control, process, handle and protect your personal information while browsing or using this website. If you do not agree to the following policy, you may wish to cease viewing or using this website.

## Information Collection

When someone visits [cabar.asia](http://cabar.asia) we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website. On our site we collect the following:

- Name;
- Email address;
- City;
- IP Address.

The information collected from you is used:

- To improve the website;
- To improve customer service;
- To send periodic emails.

## Services

We do not include or offer third party products or services on our website.

## Tracking and Personal Data

- We do not allow third party behavioural tracking and have not enabled Google Adwords on our site;
- We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer personally identifiable information.

## Use of Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

**We use cookies to:**

- Improve performance of the site;
- Compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We use Google Analytics to track this information on our behalf;
- We honour Do Not Track and do not track, plant cookies, or use advertising when a Do Not Track (DNT) browser mechanism is in place;
- Users can visit our site anonymously.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Name	Purpose	About
_gat	Performance	This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics, according to documentation it is used to throttle the request rate - limiting the collection of data on high traffic sites. It expires after 1 minute.
_gid	Performance	This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics. It is used to distinguish users.
_ga	Performance	This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics. This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports. It expires after 2 years.
pll_language	Performance	This cookie name is associated with WordPress. This cookie is used to remember your language navigation.
cookie-agreed	Cookie notice	This cookie manages the cookie notice that pops up when you visit our site. It expires after 100 day

## Search

Our website search is powered by WordPress custom search. Search queries and results are logged anonymously to help us improve our website and search functionality. No identifiable personal information is collected by us or WordPress.

## Website Security

We use WordPress, a proven, secure CMS and application framework that stands up to the most critical internet vulnerabilities. WordPress is developed with high security standards in mind. There are also regular security updates that are released every now and then to address recent issues.

The connection between your browser and our website is encrypted using TLS v1.2 (Transport Layer Security protocol). It is the latest standard technology for keeping an internet connection secure by encrypting any data that is being sent between two systems, preventing criminals from reading and modifying any information transferred, including potential personal details.

HTTPS (Hyper Text Transfer Protocol Secure) appears in the URL when a website is secured by an SSL certificate. The details of the certificate, including the issuing authority and the corporate name of the website owner, can be viewed by clicking on the lock symbol on the browser bar.
